NOTES

1. The playoff to determine the order of triples for the 2009 Celtic Challenge will take place in Bushy Park on Saturday, 13th September.
2. Since there are nine teams there will be eight rounds of a round robin, and an early start is required. **All players to be at Bushy Park at 9.15am to start sharp at 9.30am.**
3. Please ensure that George Davidson has your mobile number. In the unlikely event that Bushy Park is flooded on the day, then the playoff will be shifted to Herbert Park, and you will be contacted by mobile.
4. If a selected player is unable or does not wish to participate in the playoff it is essential that he/she gets in touch immediately with the secretary of the selectors, Jim Ryan. The selectors will then examine how to best reorganise the triples so that those in the same triple as the drop out can be accommodated. It is most unlikely that the drop out will be positioned on another triple.
5. Most of those designated as substitutes are unable to participate in the September the 13th playoff.
6. The first four triples in the playoff will represent Ireland A, the next four Ireland B and the last triple will be asked to be in reserve.
7. In the event of a tie on games won, the further determining factors will be points difference and then the result of the game between the contenders.
8. At the Celtic Challenge itself, if a player cannot participate the selectors will designate a substitute. The substitute may be one of the super subs or may be a player from the ninth triple.
9. All participants must be fully paid up members of the IPA. The current subscription is €17/£12.50 if you are a member of an affiliated club, or €22/£16 if you are not. Please make payments out to the IPA and deliver to Jim Ryan, before the 13th September.
10. **Directions to Bushy Park:** Bushy Park is on the south side of Dublin, south of Terenure, west of Rathfarnham, north of Templeogue. The N81 exit from the M50 direction east goes through Templeogue north towards Terenure. Bushy Park is beside the N81, on the east (right, from M50 and Templeogue). On the Terenure end of the park there is an estate road, **Rathdown Avenue**; along this avenue, with its mini roundabouts, to its end there is a gate into the park; after 70 metres along the path is the boules piste. 11. **Please bring food and drink for the day.** There is a kiosk that sells drinks and coffee nearby. There will be no lunch period. When you are free, or sitting out, try to ensure that you have your lunch and assist in keeping the games going. The pistes will not be marked out. The grass or the kerbs will be the boundaries.
12. As you may be aware, the Celtic Challenge 2009 will be in Cork. Two weeks before it the Irish Triples will be held at the same piste, and all selected triples will be expected to participate.
