

2 jacks

- 3 individual players compete against each other.
- Each player has 3 boules.
- One player (A) starts (drawing lots) and first throws two jacks instead of one!

Both jacks must be thrown at least 6 meters with one hand at the same time.

- Each jack is counted. That means: all players follow the normal game rules, of trying to place your boule as close to the jack as possible. However on this occasion, the player has a choice of which jack to point to, or they can try and point to a position in between the 2 jacks, allowing a point to be awarded closest to both jacks.

When awarding points, the same rules apply to each piggy like the basic game.

Gameplay

- Player A throws their first boule.
- Player B and Player C then follow one after the other with their first boules.
- From now on, the player whose boule is worse placed, throws next.

Play with normal rules, except 2 jacks are in play.
