

## 3 boules vs 6 boules

Who wins?

Aim of the game:

- A single player competes against a Doubles team, with the single player given a 12 - 0 advantage.

3 boules against 6 boules "to the target".

How to play

- the single player as well as each player from the doubles team have 3 boules each.
- The game starts with the score set at 12:0 for the single player. The doubles team begins with their first throw.
- The game is played according to the normal rules.
- Comment:

It would appear that the single player has the advantage however, winning is not as easy as it seems.

The doubles team throw the cochonnet to a distance of approx 6-7 m.

A well placed $1^{\text {st }}$ boule by the single player can easily be shot away by the doubles team. Now that the doubles team have a better boules number in hand, they can determine the outcome easily.
