## Game forms/variants Boule

7+4 = 11

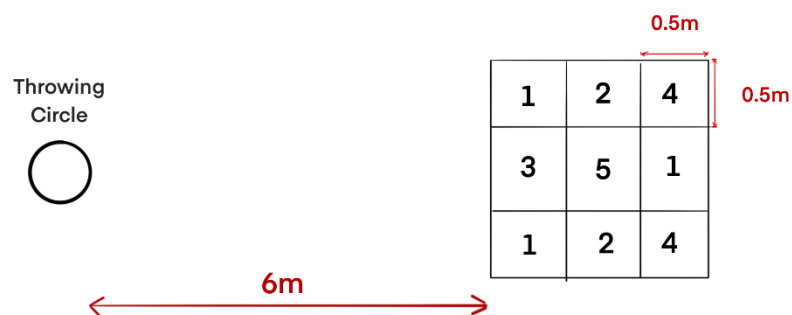
Aim of the game:

Each player throws his boules into boxes marked with different scoring points.

Playing into the field of boxes so that the total number of points scored is at least 7 and a maximum of 11. The best total decides victory.

Gameplay

- 2 or more players play against each other.
- A playing field is set up according to the following diagram.



Points vary from 1 to 5 and are assigned to the target boxes, as shown in the diagram above.

A player must play their 3 boules each round, with a maximum of 5 rounds.

Whatever box the boule remains in, the player is awarded with those points.

The points achieved are added together.

If the ball remains outside the fields of boxes, 3 points are deducted.

Note: If this results in a negative score, the total score will be 0.

If a player has scored at least 7 after 3 throws, they can stick at that score and not play any more boules. They must declare this immediately, and allow the opponent to throw their 3 boules.

The following applies: If players have the same score, whoever scored it first is declared the winner.

Only results from 7 – 11 apply.

You can only win, if you score between 7 and 11 points. Anything above or below does not count.
