

Tic Tac Toe

## Aim of the game

2 players try to point their boules into a 9-space system so that they be the first to occupy 3 spaces in a row.

## Gameplay

- Each player has 1 ball.
- A playing field with 9 circles (diameter 0.5 m ) is laid out as follows.


## Target field





From the throwing circle, the players take turns throwing their boule so that it finishes in one of the circles of the target field. This field is marked with a small marker (colored piece of paper or mark the initials of the player on the ground)

- Each player tries to be the first to get 3 in a row (horizontal, vertical or diagonal). You an only occupy an empty circle.
- If a player has occupied 3 spaces but they do not yet form a row, they throw their next boule into an unoccupied field. Then they can then have one of their own markers, moved into this space.


## Game Variations

- Make the circles larger or smaller to vary difficulty.
- Lengthen or shorten the throwing distance.
- The boule is placed and remains in a field after being thrown.
- A player can shoot into a field that is already occupied by the opponent.

In this case, the opponent's marker is removed and your own marker is placed there.
